

A TRIBUTE IN MEMORY OF OFFME HONORARY PRESIDENT GENERAL THE REVEREND DR. DIXON A. BARR



It was with shock and a heavy heart that members of the Order of First Families of Maine, and the hereditary community at-large, learned of the passing of The Reverend Dr. Dixon A. Barr, OFFME Honorary President General. Dixon suffered a massive stroke on __ October 2009 and was lost to us shortly thereafter.

Rev. Barr was a founding member of our Order (F7). He was a very dear friend of Rev. Robert Todd Giffin, the Orders Founder and first President General, and served as his mentor in this society and others. He followed Robert in the office of President General and served from 2007-2009. His efforts and dedication to this Society were responsible for initiating and accomplishing many milestone projects during his term of office, such as: the completion of Charter membership; the creation of the Orders insignia; the naming of and compilation of the first newsletter; establishment of a website; development of an electronic application; publication of the first membership directory and the Order's incorporatoin/charter in the State of Maine.

Dixon's wit and humor, his active participation in many hereditary societies and his support and friendship for others, plus his jovial phone calls, are just a few of the many things that those close to him will forever remember, cherish and sorely miss. †
