The Fifth Annual Meeting of the Order of the First Families of Maine ("the Order") was called to order on Tuesday, April 12 2010, at 3:50 p.m., at The Army & Navy Club, Washington, D.C., President General Karen A. Miller and Secretary General, Susan Y. Smith, being present.

Since this was a joint meeting with the Order of the First Families of New Hampshire, the opening rituals were shared. OFFNH Governor General Shari Worrell called the joint meeting to order. **OFFME** Chaplain General Lawrence Casey gave the invocation. Member Barbara Smith led the Pledge of Allegiance. Member Leslie Steuben led the American's Creed.

OFFNH Officers conducted their 2nd Annual business meeting. OFFNH and/or **OFFME** members who were heads of other societies were recognized:

The reading of the Minutes of the Fourth Annual Meeting of **OFFME** was dispensed with inasmuch as they had been approved by the Executive Committee and distributed to members in attendance.

President General Karen Miller thanked Marlene Wilkinson for serving as Parliamentarian.

Reports of Officers

President General Karen Miller noted her accomplishments over the last year.

First Vice President Kim Nagy read her report. Second Vice President Shari Worrell read her report.

Chaplain General Larry Casey read his report.

Secretary General Sue Smith read her report.

Treasurer General Judy Swan read her report.

Registrar General James Hancock was not in attendance; his report was read by Secretary General Sue Smith.

Historian General Timothy Finton read his report.

Committee Reports

Historian General Tim Finton discussed the Old Fort Western Fund, as noted in his report and recommended **OFFME** support this in the amount of \$1,000.00. No seconded is needed as the recommendation comes from committee. The motion was approved.

Web Mistress Kim Nagy noted that the website had over 1,600 "hits" over the last year.

Bylaws Committee Chairman Kim Nagy noted the committee members of John Bourne, Melissa Fischer, and Karen Miller (ex-officio). She reviewed the three proposed bylaws changes that had been previously transmitted to members: (1) clarifying the terms of office in Section 4. Officers' Election and Nominating Committee; (2) adding a paragraph in Section 5. Officer Duties, to add an Honorary President for Life capability; and (3) clarifying the composition of the Executive Board by adding Honorary Presidents General to the list. There was no discussion. **OFFME** members in attendance approved the proposed changes.

First Vice President Kim Nagy moved that **OFFME** Founder, the Rev. Robert Todd Giffin be elected Honorary President General and the late Rev. Dr. Dixon A. Barr be elected as Honorary President General (posthumously). Second Vice President Shari Worrell seconded. The motion was approved.

Nominating Committee Chairman Shari Worrell recognized the other members of the Committee: Judy Swan and John Hallberg Jones. She read the 2011-2013 slate:

President General Karen Miller appointed a committee of Shari Worrell, Kim Nagy, and Larry Casey to review the minutes of the Fifth Annual Meeting.

Second Vice President Shari Worrell (outgoing) administered the oath of office to the incoming slate.

Karen Miller was elected Honorary President General by the members present. President General Kimberly Nagy presented her with a beautiful crystal gavel thanking her for her service to **OFFME**.

The benediction was given by Chaplain General Larry Casey. The meeting was adjourned at 4:15 p.m. Members then attended the Joint Reception/Tea with OFFNH.
