



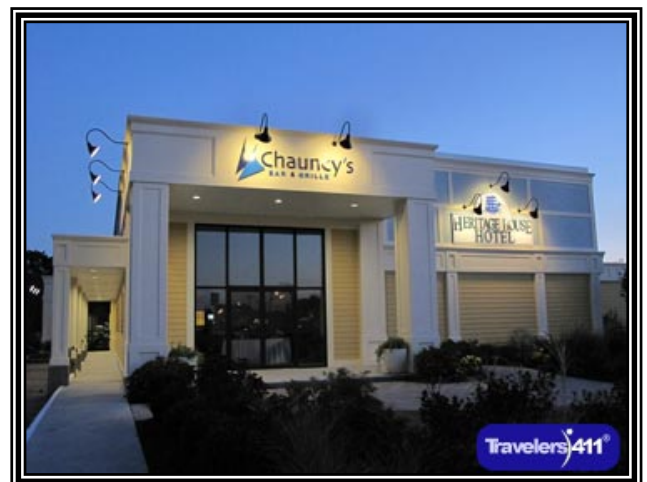

Two primary airports service Cape Cod. Please see directions from Airports to Cape below.

Boston's Logan Airport – Offers bus service to a drop-off point on the Cape, and individual hotels will send their shuttles to that drop-off point to get you to your final destination.

Providence's Green International Airport – Check with the Airport or your hotel to see whether service is available from the Airport to the Cape.

Car rentals also are available at both airports. Providence is geographically more closely located to the Cape.

Calling the Hotel is recommended in order to determine the best course for your travels. Consider pricing when determining your airport, as it may be less expensive to fly into Providence. We recommend calling your hotel to schedule your pick-up ahead of time.

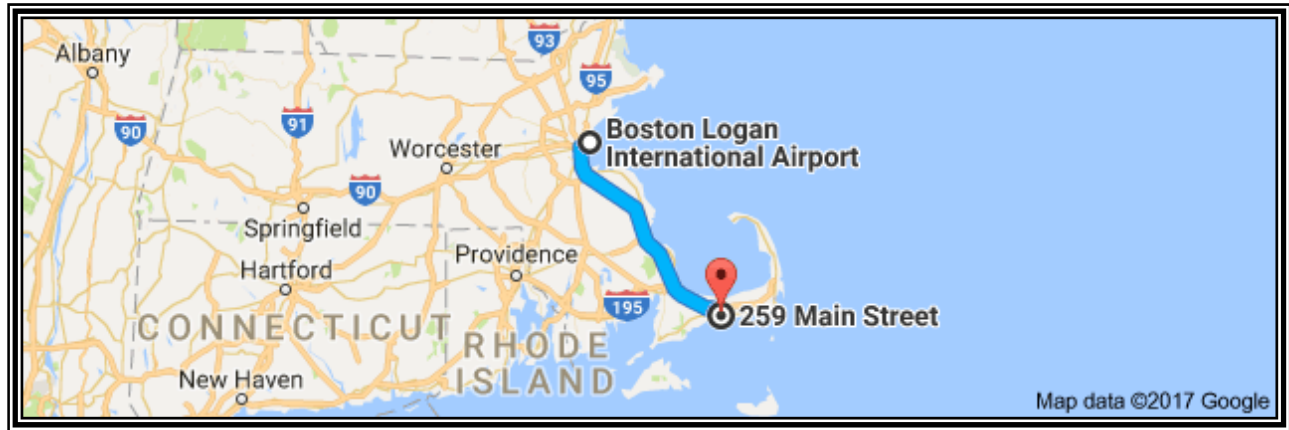

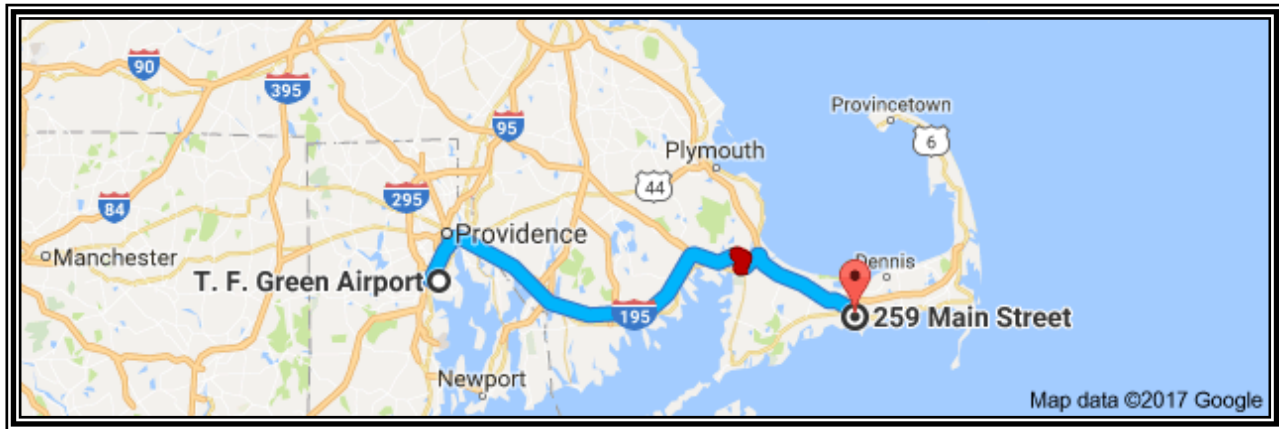
